

## Reception Homework Grid - Autumn 2<sup>nd</sup> 2017

The tasks in this homework link to our topic 'Festivals'

Please choose **a minimum of 3 tasks to complete** throughout this half term.

They should be completed gradually rather than all at once and can be returned to your child's teacher when completed.

If a piece of homework suggests video/photo evidence you can either email your child's teacher or upload to tapestry.

<p>Research and Autumn or Winter festival and make a poster using the information you find out. (Festival ideas: Rosh Hashanah, Diwali, Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Halloween, Christmas etc.)</p> <p><b>Understanding the World</b></p>	<p>Write a list of your favourite toys.  (Maybe this could be a list to send to Santa?)</p> <p><b>Literacy</b></p>	<p>Use objects from around the house to create simple addition calculations. Add together the two groups and find the total. Record your work by taking a photograph, drawing a picture or writing the number sentence (e.g. <math>4 + 2 = 6</math>).</p> <p><b>Mathematics</b></p>
<p>Find objects in your house with the same initial sound as the names of people in your family. Draw a picture and write the sounds you can hear. If possible, try to label the objects you find.</p> <p><b>Literacy</b></p>	<p>Make your own decoration for the class Christmas tree.</p> <p><b>Expressive Arts and Design</b></p>	<p>Learn and sing a Christmas song to share with the class.</p> <p>Video evidence sent through tapestry or e-mail or to sing in front of the class.</p> <p><b>Communication and Language</b></p>
<p>Go on a 3D shape hunt around your house. Which shape can you find the most of?</p> <p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p>Make an Autumn or Winter collage. Can you talk about some of the changes that happen?</p> <p><b>Expressive Arts and Design</b></p>	<p>Play a board game with your family, taking turns and following the rules.</p> <p>Photograph evidence</p> <p><b>PSED</b></p>
