

Reception Homework Grid – Autumn 1st Half 2018

Please choose a minimum of 3 tasks to complete over this half term.

Please return work to your child's teacher gradually rather than all at the end of half term.

If a piece of homework requires a video or photo evidence, you can either email your child's teacher or upload to Tapestry.

<p>Make handprints of your family's hands, cut them out and order them according to their size. Who has the biggest hands? Who has the smallest hands?</p> <p>Mathematics/EAD/PD</p>	<p>Make some stick puppets of your favourite story. Retell the story using the stick puppets. (Maybe someone at home could play one of the characters!)</p> <p>Video/Photo evidence. EAD/PD/CLL/Literacy</p>	<p>Make your own number bunting which we could hang in the classroom. You could either make 1-10, 1-20 or 10-20. The bunting could be any shape/size/colour. Be as creative as you want but remember you must put numbers on it!</p> <p>PD/EAD/Mathematics</p>
<p>Present your name in 5 different ways. For example colourful, typed, using stones, in the sand, using twigs, counters, coins etc. You may need to use photo evidence for some.</p> <p>Literacy/PD/EAD</p>	<p>Take 4 photos of signs of Autumn. Print them out and stick them on colourful paper. Can you try to label them too? e.g. Autumn leaves, conkers, rain, the night sky, harvested fields, spiders, pumpkins.</p> <p>UTW/Literacy</p>	<p>Make Stickman's family! You can use anything you like e.g. playdough, sticks, paper, paper towel rolls. Remember the family are different sizes!</p> <p>EAD/PD/Mathematics</p>
<p>Watch a Julia Donaldson story on YouTube or you may even have a DVD (there are also some on Netflix) or listen to an adult read you the story. Draw a picture about it and write a sentence about the story.</p> <p>PD/Literacy</p>	<p>Make a shape picture using 2D shapes. Try to label a square, rectangle, triangle, semi-circle and circle. How many of each shape have you used?</p> <p>EAD/PD/Mathematics</p>	<p>Post a letter/picture/photo to the class at school. Make sure you put your teacher's name on the envelope! The school address is on our website.</p> <p>UTW/Literacy/EAD</p>
