

Group 1 - Spring 2nd half term 2021 Level 5

The children will continue to learn Phase 5 sounds this term.

What are common exception words? These are words sometimes referred to as 'tricky words'. They are words that don't follow a spelling or phonics rule. We are trying to teach the children about the spelling rules and not simply learning the rules for the test, as children tend not to be able to apply if learnt this way.

Please encourage your children to learn their spellings via their spelling shed password and to write them on paper when you say them.

For those who need challenge, say the words in a sentence (dictation). Say the sentence aloud and your child has to write the whole sentence using the correct punctuation and spelling.
